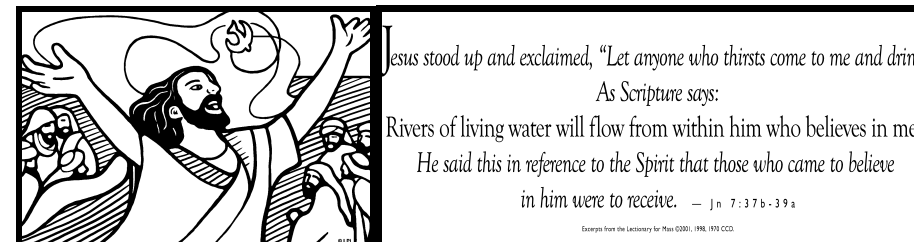

**From the Desk of Fr. Michael**

This weekend, Archbishop Sample is ordaining two candidates to Sacred Orders of Priesthood. The Sacrament of Holy Orders is one of the seven sacraments that is conferred on a baptized man who has heard God calling him to a particular role in the Church.

When a priest is ordained, he is configured to Christ in order to carry out the ministerial work of acting in the power of Christ through presiding at Mass, absolving sinners, anointing the sick, proclaiming and explaining the Gospel, bestowing blessings, and in his pastoral leadership of building up the body of Christ in the faith community.

We are truly blessed to have two newly ordained priests, Frs. Hans Mueller and Zani Pacanza to serve in the Archdiocese of Portland in Oregon. Furthermore, we are blessed also with the current priests that have been serving faithfully.

There is one in particular that I would like to acknowledge as he reaches a significant marking in his priesthood. Fr. Jeff Meeuwsen, a Roy boy, graduate of St. Francis of Assisi grade school, Valley Catholic High School, and Gonzaga University will be celebrating his 10<sup>th</sup> Anniversary.

On Sunday, June 18<sup>th</sup> at the 10:30am Mass in Roy where he celebrated his FIRST Mass as a priest on the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, the Most Precious Body and Blood of Jesus Christ, he will be celebrating a Mass of Thanksgiving for 10 years as a priest. You are all invited to join in celebration by attending the Mass with a reception to follow.
