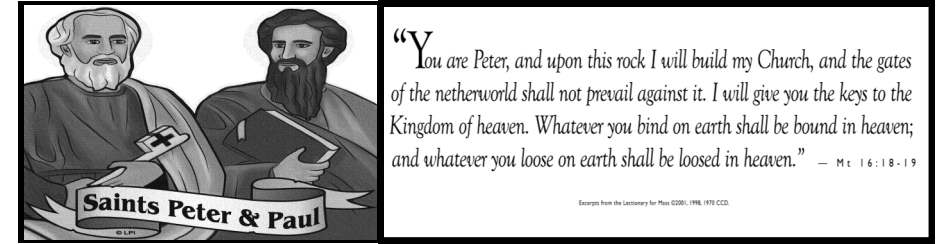

**From the Desk of Fr. Michael**

This Sunday, June 25, at the wee hours of the morning, 26 teens and 6 adult chaperones will be departing to Louisiana. This is the 3<sup>rd</sup> Mission Trip that we have organized. Much like the 1<sup>st</sup> Mission Trip, we are partnering up with St. Bernard Project.

This year, St. Bernard Project has assigned us to help construct homes for those who were affected by the August 2016 floods that accumulated 31 inches of rainwater in the Baton Rouge and Lafayette area. Over 30,000 residents had to be relocated while approximately 146,000 homes were damaged. The Mission group will be working in the Livingston Parish at 3 work sites.

Due to the location of our work sites, the Mission group will be staying at the Catholic Life Center in Baton Rouge. The Catholic Life Center is the old seminary, but now serves as the diocesan retreat center. The Diocese of Baton Rouge was so moved by our group traveling over 2400 miles to help that they have offered to pay for a hot breakfast and brown bag lunch each day for our participants.

Needless to say, I am greatly appreciated as in the past years, we had the group stay at a local State Park and we had to shop at Costco to stock up each cabin with food. Although I did look forward shopping at Costco, filling 3 full carts and being asked what I was doing and explaining our work, it is still nice to not have to do this task and errand.

Also, the Governor of Louisiana, Governor Edwards, a good Catholic, heard of what our group is doing and very much appreciative, has arranged for a meeting with us to express his gratitude. Not only are we going to have an audience with the Governor, we will also have opportunity to take in the local culture.

This year, Fr. Jamin arranged for steamboat dinner cruise on the mighty Mississippi River, a visit to the WWII museum, and to Cajun village for dinner and live music on top of the usual Swamp and plantation tour.

This Mission trip is an opportunity to work together with the teens and adults at St. Margaret of Scotland as well as build bridges of friendship, fellowships, and service in the name of Christ whom we all are called to follow.

Please keep the 2017 Mission Krewe in your prayers for the upcoming week.
