As it is our custom here at all three parishes on the 2nd weekend of the month to invite parishioners celebrating significant markings in their lives, i.e., wedding anniversaries and birthdays, I cannot think of a better way than to acknowledge the blessings of Marriage and Family.

In this month of July, two daughters of Verboort and Roy respectively celebrate a significant marking. Sr. Clare Vandecoevering, SSMO and Sr. Charlene Herinckx, SSMO will be recognized for 70 and 50 years of Religious Profession. Needless to say, this is an incredible witness of faith, especially to their vows of poverty, chastity, and obedience.

The SSMO community invites all of us to their Mass of Jubilee on Sunday, July 30, 2017 at 1:30pm in the Our Lady of Perpetual Help Chapel at the Motherhouse, Beaverton. There will be a reception after the Mass as well.
