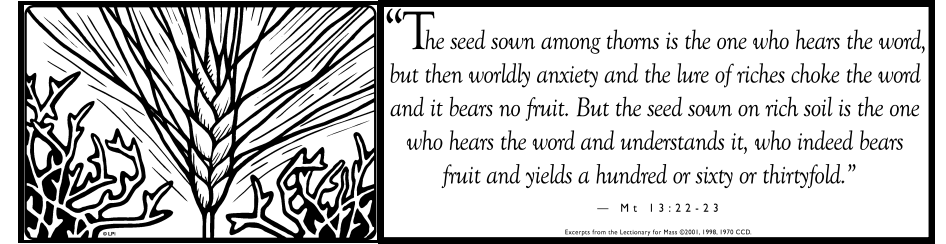

From the Desk of Fr. Michael

We are in what is known as the dog days of summer. Parish life comes to a screeching halt as religious education programs, the school and other parish activities take a break. Although the campus is relatively quiet, we all know that in less than 2 months the return of teachers, faculty and staff will be upon us.

During these quiet days in which the only activity is morning Mass, one task that is necessary, is to commence upon pastoral/sacramental planning. I am excited to say that the calendar, lesson plans, and topics and themes for RCIA, Middle School Youth Group, HS Youth Group, and HS Confirmation are set.

Furthermore, there are two events that are in the works. The Vicariate is planning a Youth Rally scheduled for Oct. 6-8, 2017 hosted at St. Anthony's in Forest Grove. This is a three-day event in which we will have opportunity for speakers, confession, Eucharistic Adoration, and Mass for Young Adults (Friday), Middle Schoolers (Saturday) and HS Schoolers (Sunday).

The theme is entitled: Fake News vs GOOD NEWS, how to discern and witness to the Truth in the world. The talks will be age appropriate, but will provide our Young People the knowledge and tools to combat a world that is changing the Truth on marriage, family, relationships, and human dignity.

The second event is the Mission Krewe 2018 to Anchorage, Alaska. This is the 5th Mission Trip and the decision has been made to venture to the Great Frontier. This will be a life changing and once in a lifetime opportunity for not only our teens and adult chaperones in rural Washington County, but also for our friends from Louisiana.

I am in the process of coordinating with Habitat for Humanity and Catholic Social Services of Anchorage for our Mission group to volunteer three days while the other days take advantage of seeing the natural beauty and wonders of Alaska such as the wildlife, glaciers, and rich history. My hope is to have dates finalized and costs secured.

In September when we kick off the new religious education and school year, hopefully the hours of planning devoted during this month of July will be successful and provide an opportunity for all to grow in their faith.
