From the Desk of Fr. Michael

As I shared with my daily Mass goers, two Saturdays ago, I noticed a cyclist sitting on Vern's bench to catch his breath. After awhile I decided to check up on him. To my surprise, he inquired when this altar was used for services. Then I realized he was referring to the empty pedestal that holds the Holy Family statue.

As many of you know, during the December 2016 wind storm, the forces of mother nature lifted up the Holy Family statue donated by the Tom and Cindy Sagar and family into the air and it crashed into the ground damaging the back of St. Joseph's head.

Thankfully, Evelyn and Dave Herinckx are neurosurgeons when it comes to plaster and repaired St. Joseph. Due to the type of material of the Holy Family statue, the Facilities committee and I decided that it would be best to relocate the statue indoors, preferably inside the new school.

With that said, we ordered a new Holy Family that is more equipped to brave the elements as it is an outdoor statue. It just arrived and will be installed onto the pedestal. Once this has been done, we will have a dedication of not only the new statue but also Vern's bench after the 10am Sunday Mass.

Besides this project, we were approved for the Archdiocesan Matching Safety Grant to restripe and reseal the parking lot of the Parish Center as well as surrounding areas around the parish center and the rectory driveway. Once all these projects are complete, we will add to the paved walkways for all those parishioners, visitors and guests to enjoy the beauty of our campus especially during the Verboort Dinner.

Special thanks to the members of the Facilities Committee and to all of you as without your generous financial support this would not be possible.

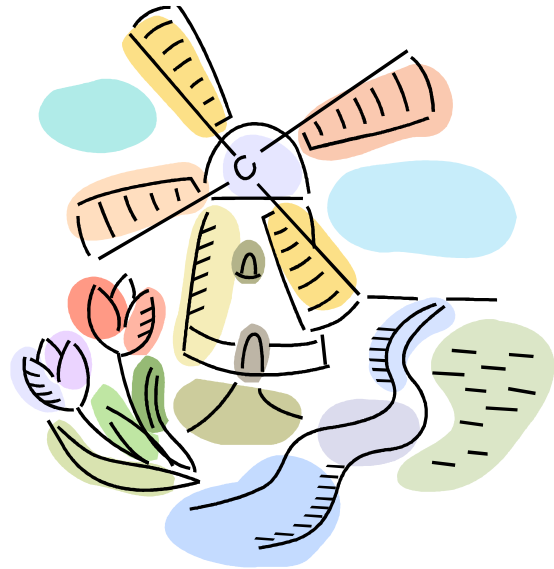
